What is NAAHP?

The National Association of Advisors for the Health Professions is an organization of just over 1,000 health professions advisors at colleges and universities throughout the United States, and representatives from professional schools and associations.

NAAHP was established in 1974 to facilitate communication among the four independent regional associations—Central (CAAHP), Northeast (NEAHP), Southeast (SAHP) and West (WAAHP)—from which it derives its strength and its membership. Health professions advisors across the nation function together and speak with one voice through NAAHP. NAAHP has grown steadily from that beginning into an effective national clearinghouse for opinions of advisors and news from allopathic and osteopathic medicine, chiropractic, dental, naturopathic, nursing, occupational and physical therapy, physician assistant, podiatric medicine, public health, optometry, pharmacy, health administration and veterinary medical schools. In addition, NAAHP has established collaborations with health professions schools and their associations through advisor liaisons and an Advisory Council comprised of representatives from these associations.

The success of NAAHP is directly dependent upon its four regional associations. NAAHP encourages each regional group and individual member to communicate fully their experiences and information with other regions and advisors. All advisors are given a nationally recognized forum in which to state their views and share their research studies through its publication, *The Advisor*.

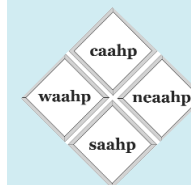

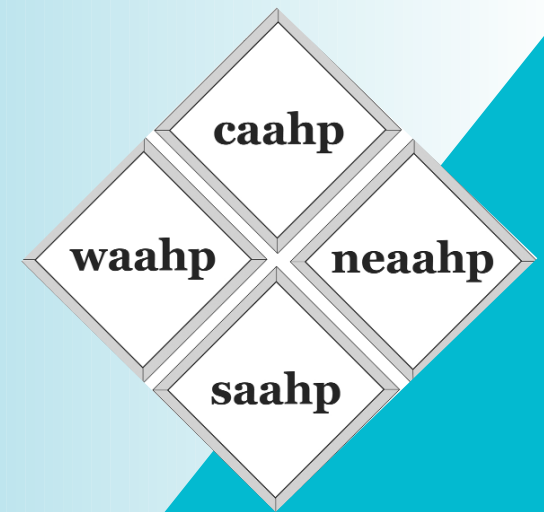
